- Be a U. S. Citizen or National
- Be a Veteran enrolled in an undergraduate program in professional engineering or computer science at an accredited college or university in the MD, VA, DC metropolitan area
- Should be entering the senior year of study, with completion of degree between May 2015 and December 2015
- Have at least a 2.95 overall grade point average on a 4.0 scale or equivalent
